High Quality Learning Experiences

- We have been recognised as a model of good practice in Play Pedagogy within NLC, West Partnership and at a National Level.
- Two members of staff have been trained at authority level; they will now upskill other members of staff to ensure there is consistency across the primaries.
- •We will now extend this approach, ensuring that all children within Primary 1 to 3 will learn through the playbased approach.
- ·Children will be provided with opportunities to use new concrete resources which in turn will support and challenge their number development and knowledge.

Skills for Learning, Life and Work

- SMART Pupil Council will meet fortnightly to share their opinions and make suggestions about how to improve their school.
- The school values will continue to be embedded into the daily lives of all children in St Michael's. This will be celebrated at Assemblies and a special Value Lunch.
- •The children will be provided with opportunities to develop Higher Order Thinking Skills, e.g. problem solving, critical thinking.

Tracking and Monitoring

- Teachers and SMT will hold regular meetings to discuss the progress of each child.
- Develop tracking procedures across all curricular areas.
- Girfme Plans will be provided for children who require support in accessing the curriculum.
- ·Wider achievements will be recorded and celebrated, we will also ensure that all children have access to extra-curricular activities during after school clubs.

- ·Vision, values and aims will be refreshed.
