FUTURE DATES FOR YOUR DIARY

We are delighted to be able to give our children the opportunity to take part in many different extra-curricular clubs during lunchtimes and after school. Further details have been sent out separately. If your child was not allocated a place there will be a further block of clubs in the new year.

CHRISTMAS LUNCH

This will take place on Wednesday 3rd December and is always a highlight of our Christmas calendar. More information regarding the menu and how to order will be sent out shortly. SACRAMENTS

STAY AND PLAY/DROP IN SESSIONS



If you have a child under 3, our popular Stay & Play sessions for toddlers have restarted on Fridays from 9.00 until 10.30 a.m. There is no need to book a place, please enter via the nurture room fire door. There is also an opportunity to meet with our Barnardos worker

Monica, on an informal basis, on Wednesday mornings between 9.00 and 10.30 a.m.

BREAKFAST CLUB

This supervised service is available to all our children from 8.15 a.m. All children must be supervised until they enter the building. Parents should be aware that any children arriving before 8.15 a.m. may not have access to the building until Breakfast Club staff arrive. Please be aware that all children attending must purchase a breakfast. The breakfast consists of cereal, milk and toast. This is free to pupils who are in Primary 1 to 5 and for pupils in Primary 6 to 7 who receive free school meals. For all other pupils the cost is £1 per day with a sliding scale for families of two at £1.50 per day and families of three at £1.80 per day. Children will then be dismissed into the playground at 8.45 a.m.

SMART PUPIL COUNCIL UPDATE

This year the SMART Pupil Council are continuing our hard work in Promoting Children's Rights and Pupil Voice as part of our Right's Respecting School Journey. At the start of term all classes focused on four articles, we learned that these particular articles helped inform the adults on how to get it right for every child (GIRFEC). We created new wall displays and shared what we have learned at assemblies. We have identified that we would like to celebrate achievement in Numeracy alongside our certificates for Star Writer, Values, STEM, Reading School and Digital. So far this year during our fortnightly meetings, the SMART Pupil Council have identified that they would like a new school show. They wrote a letter persuading Mrs Greechan to permit us to buy one and we were successful. Using our class meeting tool, where every child gets a voice, the children have chosen our next Spring Show. They have also shared their ideas on how to make playtimes and lunchtimes more fun. The children also chose which school clubs they would like the teachers to deliver, alongside the different events for the fun day. We are enjoying having a voice within our school and we hope to continue to ensure that our school is a place where we can enjoy learning and work together as a community.

SENIORS LUNCH



Last year we invited the more senior members of our community along to the school for an afternoon of hospitality. The catering staff kindly supplied soup, sandwiches and cakes. The senior children took great enjoyment in serving our guests and the choir entertained. This year we intend to run this successful event again on Monday 15th Dec at 1.30 p.m.
