The children are encouraged to have the same standards of presentation in their homework jotter as in class: a date, heading, underline with a ruler etc.



P.E.

Our P.E. sessions will continue to take place on a Wednesday and Friday. We currently have around 1/3 of our class who regularly do not bring a PE kit to school. It would be great to see all of our children being able to change into comfortable clothes and shoes to participate fully in PE, especially as we move into warmer months where we will be taking our PE outdoors.
