


St Michael's Nursery

Dear Parent/Carer,

Children who are starting school in August have been issued with their transition packs and we look forward to starting our transition events. Keep an eye on our Nursery Team for photos of them getting ready for school.

Toilet Training

We have noticed a number of children who are not yet fully toilet trained. We appreciate that young children are prone to 'accidents' and are happy to help to change if and when required. Please ensure, unless there is a medical reason for your child not yet being toilet trained, which we are already aware of, that children have had three dry days at home before returning to nursery. Health Visitors can support you if you need guidance with this.



Clothing

We are running low on spare clothes. If a child does go home with spare nursery clothes on, please make sure that this is washed and returned to us. Every child has a small green bag on their peg, and we ask that there are two spare changes in this for if a child gets wet or dirty. This includes socks as we are running low on these. Children love to play in our water area, and with the recent particularly wet weather we have had, socks have required to be changed more often than normally. Your support with this is appreciated.



Cloakrooms

When dropping off or collecting your child for nursery, please have a look to see if they have all of their belongings. Our cloakrooms have become full of jumpers, hats, gloves etc and we don't know who they all belong to. Any items left lying at the end of next week (Friday 27th March), will be put into lost property and spare nursery clothing.

Easter Holidays

For AM and PM we will have 1 sessions for all children to attend together from 9.00 a.m. until 1.45 p.m. We look forward to seeing everyone back at nursery on Monday 20th April and during this week we will be welcoming our last two children for the remainder of the session.
