

School dinners newsletter

As our pupils have returned and settled into a new school year our catering team would like to provide some information and updates on school meals.

School dinners are £3.55 - this consists of a 2 course meal, additional free fruit and a choice of milk or water to drink.

Breakfast club is £1.10 and opens at 8.15am, pupils have the choice of toast, cereal, fresh fruit and drinks.

All pupils up to Primary 5 are entitled to a free school meal, including breakfast if they wish and for P6 & P7 pupils this entitlement is means tested and can be applied for on the North Lanarkshire Council website.

You can also view our menus on the council website and sign up for weekly email alerts so you know what's on the menu in the following week.

Pupils entitled to a free school meal can access a free meal top up if they bring a packed lunch to school. This includes soup of the day, fruit and a drink. They can ask a member of the catering team for this during lunch time.

Allergies and special diets are taken very seriously by the catering team and North Lanarkshire Council. If your child has a food allergy or intolerance please complete the special diet form on the council website and upload proof. This will be reviewed by our team of nutritionists so we can provide the best and safest options for individual pupils.

Our Catering Staff provide a tuck shop at breaktime every day consisting of

- Toast 40p
- Biscuit 40p
- Cereal Bars 70p

- Popcorn 80p
- Fresh fruit 50p

This is an optional extra and is paid for by loading money to the school meals account through iPay. The school office staff can provide help with setting this up.

Any questions about school meals can be sent to the office staff who will communicate with the catering manager to give accurate answers.

We hope to see you at parents night in October, the catering team will be there to provide information and maybe some free samples!
