Dear Parents/Carers

We would like to take the opportunity to welcome you back to another year of working in partnership with St Michael's Primary. The children have all returned to school looking fabulous and smart in their uniforms. We are delighted to report that they have all settled in well and are already working very hard! We are excited to have this opportunity to teach your child and creating a happy and successful school year for them. Mrs Lang is in class on a Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Mrs Stevenson is in class with P3/2 on a Wednesday.

The following information will give you an idea of the routines of the class and what your child will be doing this term:



Homework

Details of homework will continue to be carried out digitally using the Class Glow Team. Children have already been added to their class team and the children were given a reminder of their passwords recently. Our class TEAM code is 3bxb3pz. An email was sent on 14/08/2026 to help with access.

Each week you will be able to find details of the homework under 'Class Materials'. I will also go over it on a Friday to ensure that children are clear in what is being asked of them. The homework itself will be focused on Spelling, Reading, Maths and R.E. The children have been given a homework jotter where they will carry out their work to the best of their ability. All homework jotters should be returned to school on a Thursday, as was stated in our homework guidelines that have already been issued. It is important that the children have their reading books in their bags **every day** to allow them to use their book in class with reading to write tasks in line with Active Literacy.

P.E. / Outdoor Learning

Our P.E. sessions will take place on a Monday and Wednesday. On P.E. days pupils are required to wear full school uniform (including shirt and tie) and to change into their P.E. kit in school. The school P.E. kit (green t-shirt and shorts) is available to order from www.logoxpres-schoolwear.co.uk. Should you not have this at the present time then pupils should bring a plain coloured t-shirt and shorts (no football colours). Indoor gym shoes are also required. In addition, pupils will require leggings or jogging trousers and a school fleece for outdoor learning. **Please send all kit in on a Monday for the week.** The children will bring gym kit/outdoor learning clothes home again every **Friday**.



Please could you ensure that all items of clothing have **names** on them as I am then able to quickly identify what belongs to who when things get lost. It would also be beneficial **to ensure that no jewellery** is worn on gym days for Health and Safety reasons. If earrings cannot be taken out, please ensure that your child has plasters to cover these.

Water Bottles

I would ask that every child bring a bottle with water to school each day. This helps keep the children hydrated whilst in class (no juice in keeping with dental initiatives). Bottles can be refilled at the water fountains within the school.



Outdoor Learning

We have the opportunity to use our school grounds for Outdoor Learning. Our Outdoor Learning activities will take place in the forest and our school grounds.

First Friday Mass

We will be attending mass in St Michael's church on the 4th of September, 2nd October, 6th November, 4th December. If you are able to support us in walking to and from mass it would be greatly appreciated.

Important - Allergies



Please remember that we are a nut free school and as such snacks or lunches containing nuts are not permitted with the school. We have pupils in school with nut allergies. Please be vigilant about packed lunches, sweets, etc and ensure that no nuts come into our school grounds.

Please do not send your child into school with any nut-based product for a snack or packed lunch - this includes:

- Nutella based products
- Spreads, e.g. chocolate spread
- Cereal bars
- Some types of biscuit containing nuts
- Condiments, e.g. satay sauce
- Cakes containing nuts
- Some snack pots containing nuts
