

#### **Loving Lunches**

lunchtime and ALL children, including those bringing a packed lunch, receive the daily dessert option.

#### **Absence**

Please telephone the nursery on the first day of absence if your child is unable to attend and if possible, give an indication of how long your child will be absent or inform your key-worker for a planned absence. If

your child is absent for longer than anticipated please contact the nursery again to keep us informed of when your child will return. There is a strict procedure all NLC nursery establishments must follow and in the case of persistent absence without contact you may receive a letter of notification advising your place will be withdrawn and you may lose your place!
