Numeracy

Place value - reading, writing, ordering 3 digit numbers

Identifying the value of a digit in a 3 digit number

Number— subtraction with 2 digit numbers within and beyond 100

Continue practise with 2,3,4,5 and 10 times tables

Division—using knowledge of multiplication

Division with remainders

Number Talks—encouraging children to develop as many strategies as possible to solve mathematical problems. And giving children the opportunity to explain

Literacy

Reading - novel studies

1. Fluency
2. Comprehension
3. Writing linked to reading novel
4. Talking and writing linked to reading

Phonics/Spelling

- Phonics—the children will learn one new phoneme per week
- Spelling—the children will be taught 5 common words per week
- Sentence work—the children will be encouraged to write longer and more detailed sentences and begin to use paragraphs
- Consolidation of work on nouns, verbs and adjectives

Consolidation Week

Every 4 weeks both in class and at home, the children will revise the previous 3 weeks sounds and common spelling words, therefore no new sounds or common words will be issued during week 4. This is in-line with North Lanarkshire Active Literacy policy. Homework will be linked to the Literacy programme.

Writing will comprise of various genres this term :

- Persuasive writing narrative
- Information reports

Social Subjects

This term the themes are

Winter– the effects of Winter weather on our lives

Knights and castles Social studies

Exploring the past through learning about historical evidence

SOC 1-07a 9a Exploring the use of land to produce food. To find out about the different types of animals on a farm and what they provide.

To match animals to their young.
