Numeracy

NumberTalks—place value, doubles, near doubles, adding in chunks, friendly numbers

Mental Maths—Daily 10, number of the day

Number—Multiplication (multiply 2,3,4,5 and 10)

Division (divide by 2,3,4,5 and 10)

Fractions -halves, quarters

Time—o'clock, half past, quarter past/to the hour

Data Handling—collating/interpreting/extracting information

Literacy

Reading - Four day reading programme that comprises: -

1. Fluency
2. Comprehension
3. Writing linked to reading novel/book
4. Talking and writing linked to reading

Phonics/Spelling

- Phonics—the children will learn new sounds/phonemes each week.
- Spelling—the children will be taught new common words each week.
- Sentences—the children will be taught how to create interesting sentences using core targets.

Grammar

- Nouns, verbs and adjectives.
- Alphabetical order.
- Using an apostrophe
- Punctuation.

Writing

The children will write in the following genres:
