Numeracy

* **Mental Maths**—increase speed and accuracy of addition and multiplication operations using games and Number Talks.

* **Whole numbers**—read, write and order whole numbers to 1,000,000 and beyond, rounding & estimation.

* **Addition & Subtraction**—use standard written methods, including carrying and decomposition up to 6/7 digits.

* Carouselling of a variety of activities comprising **shape, measure, and time.**



Literacy

Use the NLC Active Literacy 4 day reading programme.

Reading - Four day reading programme that comprises: -

1. Fluency
2. Comprehension
3. Writing linked to IDL topic— *The Scottish Parliament*
4. Reading for Information texts
5. Talking and writing linked to reading / novel— The Nowhere Emporium

The teaching of 6 comprehension strategies to develop the children's critical literacy skills.

The 6 strategies are:-

- Using Active Thinking about Prior knowledge
- Active Thinking about Metalinguistics (tricky words)
- Active Thinking about Sensory Images
- Using Active Thinking to Draw Inferences
- Using Active Thinking to Find Main Ideas
- Using Active Thinking to Summarise the Text



Phonics/Spelling

- Phonics and Spelling is combined in P7. Children will be taught a variety of spelling approaches—strategy spelling, spelling rules and vocabulary building.

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term the children will be learning about:

The Scottish Parliament

The origins of the Scottish Parliament and its relationship with the UK Parliament.

The roles and responsibilities of the Cabinet.

Debating and creating laws.

Democracy and the election process.
