Numeracy

Mental Maths: increase speed and accuracy of addition operations using single digits and doubles

- ♦ **Division**— divide whole numbers & decimal fractions by a single digit
- ♦ **Time**—read & record time in 12 & 24 hr notation, use & interpret timetables, calculate durations of activities
- ♦ **Shape**— properties of 2d shape & 3d objects
- ♦ **Fractions, decimals & percentages**— calculate and create equivalent fractions and equivalent decimal fractions, calculate percentages of quantities, calculate simple fractions of a quantity.



Literacy

Continuing to build on the work began in Terms 1 & 2 using the 4 day reading programme.

Reading - Four day reading programme that comprises: -

1. Fluency
2. Comprehension
3. Writing linked to IDL topic— *World War 2*
4. Reading for Information texts
5. Talking and writing linked to reading / novel— ***Goodnight Mr. Tom***

The teaching of 6 comprehension strategies to develop the children's critical literacy skills.

The 6 strategies are:-

- Using Active Thinking about Prior knowledge
- Active Thinking about Metalinguistics (tricky words)
- Active Thinking about Sensory Images
- Using Active Thinking to Draw Inferences
- Using Active Thinking to Find Main Ideas
- Using Active Thinking to Summarise the Text



Phonics/Spelling

- Phonics and Spelling is combined in P7. Children will be taught a variety of spelling approaches—strategy spelling, spelling rules and vocabulary building.
