Numeracy

- Number sequences to 30
- **Counting forwards to 30 and backwards** 20



- Recognise +, & = symbols
- Estimation to estimate the number of objects in groups
- Measure to explore everyday items as units of measure to investigate and compare sizes and amounts.

Literacy

From week 5, the children will use the 4 day reading programme.

Reading - Four day reading programme that comprises: -

- Fluency
- 2. Comprehension
- 3. Writing linked to reading book
- 4. Talking and listening linked to reading and topic

Phonics/Spelling

- Phonics—the children will continue to learn 2 sounds per week then 1 new phoneme per week
- Spelling the children will be taught 3/4 new common words per week
- Simple sentences—the children will be encouraged to begin to write simple sentences using the taught common words.

Consolidation week

Around every 4 weeks both in class and at home the children will revise the previous 3 weeks sounds and common spelling words, therefore no new sounds or common words will be issued during this week. This is in-line with North Lanarkshire's Active Literacy policy.

Homework will be linked to the Literacy programme.

<u>Health and Wellbeing</u> This term the children will be learning about:

- Managing our emotions Teaching children a range of strategies to help them manage their emotions promotes self-regulation, a vital skill in building their resilience.
- How to keep healthy and active— The children will become familiar with the gym hall and changing into their P.E. kit.

Social Subjects

This term the children will be learning about:

- Our School The children will become familiar with their environment and begin to get to know all staff
- People who help us— The children will have the opportunity to learn about people who can help them in and out of school
- Pirates— Children will learn about the life of a pirate from clothes and food to treasure
