The purpose of this overview is to give you an insight into what your child will be learning in each curricular area this term.



Numeracy

- Children will continue with daily number talks to increase their mental agility.
- Money
- Properties of 2D shapes and 3D objects
- Fractions, Decimal Fractions and Percentages—halves
- Time



Literacy

From week 5, the children will use the 4 day reading programme.

Reading - Four day reading programme that comprises: -

1. Fluency
2. Comprehension
3. Writing linked to reading book
4. Talking and listening linked to reading and topic

Phonics/Spelling

- Phonics—the children will revise one initial sound per week
- Spelling - the children will be taught 3/4 new common words per week
- Simple sentences- the children will be encouraged to begin to write simple sentences using the taught common words.

Consolidation week

Around every 4 weeks both in class and at home the children will revise the previous 3 weeks sounds and common spelling words, therefore no new sounds or common words will be issued during this week . This is in-line with North Lanarkshire's Active Literacy policy.

Homework will be linked to the Literacy programme.

Social Subjects


This term the children will be learning about:
