Numeracy

Place value - reading, writing, ordering 3 digit numbers

Number— addition within 100—2 digit addition

Revise 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Begin 3 and 4 times tables

Shape—identifying and describing properties of 2D and 3D shapes

Number Talks—encouraging children to develop as many strategies as possible to solve mathematical problems. And giving children the opportunity to explain how they worked out the answer to a problem.

Using Numicon— a practical resource to support number processes and place

Literacy

Reading - Four day reading programme that comprises: -

1. Fluency
2. Comprehension
3. Writing linked to reading novel
4. Talking and writing linked to reading

Phonics/Spelling

- Phonics—the children will learn one new phoneme per week
- Spelling—the children will be taught 3/4 common words per week
- Sentence work—the children will be encouraged to write longer and more detailed sentences using conjunctions
- Consolidation of work on nouns, verbs and adjectives

Consolidation Week

Every 4 weeks both in class and at home, the children will revise the previous 3 weeks sounds and common spelling words, therefore no new sounds or common words will be issued during week 4. This is in-line with North Lanarkshire Active Literacy policy. Homework will be linked to the Literacy programme.

Writing will comprise of various genres this term :

- Recount
- narrative
