Online Safety for 4 - 7 year olds

The Jessie & Friends animations are age-appropriate and do not depict any situations where adults communicate with children online. Instead, they show safe, non-scary situations which help young viewers identify things which might worry them online.

Jessie, Tia and Mo learn that when playing online games they should keep their personal information private, only talk to people they know in real life and that they can tell an adult they trust if anything happens that makes them worried.

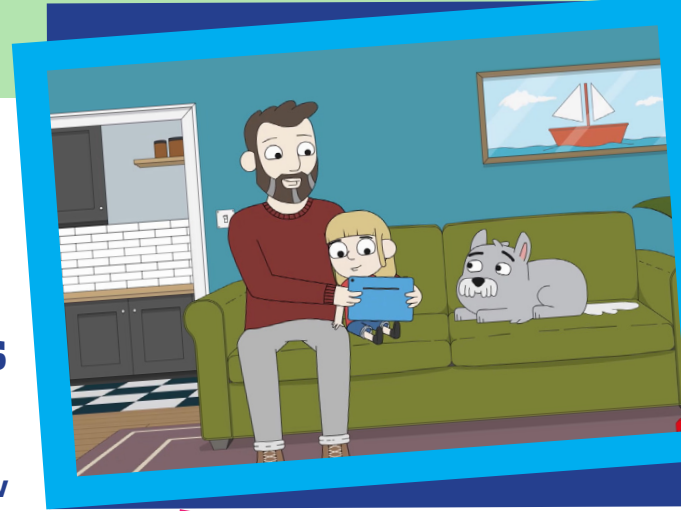
Stranger Danger

Staying Safe Everyone

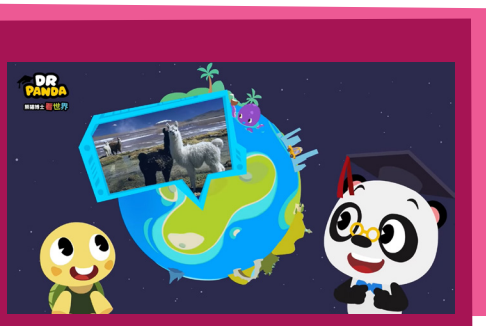
Create a Stay Safe Everyone poster to put on your house window to help prevent the spread of the coronavirus. Encourage your friends to make one too.
