


## Learning Context:

### Exploring the Well-being Woods



Over the next few weeks the children will be busy exploring their outdoor environment, observing the Autumnal changes. They will participate in discussions about changes they have noticed, exploring the different colours they see in their environment. Children will be invited to contribute to mark making experiences, and be encouraged to share their creative thoughts and ideas about Autumn.



Children will also be invited to share their creative thoughts and ideas through their participation in rhyme, song, dance and role play helping to further promote their communication skills.



Staff will continue the literacy programme, Three Reads. The programme aims to support children in developing really important literacy skills like understanding how books work, understanding stories, listening, thinking and talking about their ideas and experiences.



Children will also be introduced to Sid and SHANARRI who live in the Well-being Woods. They will help the children to develop an awareness of how to be Safe, Healthy, Active, Nurtured, Achieving, Responsible, Respected and Included, helping children to develop their self-awareness, resilience and emotional literacy.



Children will continue to explore the importance of making positive choices in their play, respecting and including their friends in their play and learning experiences, recording their experiences in their learning profiles
