

# Beds

## Phonics Skills

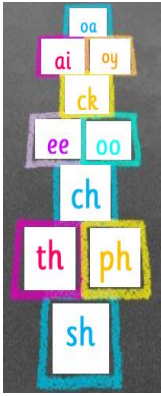
L.I – I am learning to identify and pronounce phonemes

L.I – I am learning to read a variety of common words

## Physical Skills

L.I – I am learning to develop my balance and co-ordination through hopping and jumping

L.I – I am learning to perform a safe and accurate underarm throw



You will need: - chalk/masking tape, phoneme/word cards, stone/beanbag

## How to Play

- Create a beds grid using chalk or masking tape.



- You can either use the chalk to write the phonemes/words into the grid or place the phoneme/word cards inside each box of the grid.
- Throw the stone/beanbag using an underarm throw onto the first phoneme/word on the grid.
- Travel to the top of the beds grid using hops and jumps. You have to hop or jump over the phoneme/word with the stone/beanbag on it.
- As you travel back down the grid stop at the stone/beanbag and shout out the phoneme/word.
- Pick up the stone/beanbag and travel back to the start of the grid.

## Game 2

- Use phoneme/word cards and lay them face down. That way you can't see the phoneme/word until you've travelled to collect the stone/beanbag.

## Game 3

- Ask someone to give you a phoneme/word to throw the stone/beanbag onto. This will help you to throw accurately. If you miss the grid you need to try again. If you land on the wrong phoneme/word you have to travel up the grid to collect the stone/beanbag and tell the phoneme/word. Then try again to throw onto the phoneme/word you were given.
