



Frisbee Phonics



Phonics Skills – L.I – I am learning to segment to spell words

Physical Skills – L.I - I am learning to develop my throwing skills

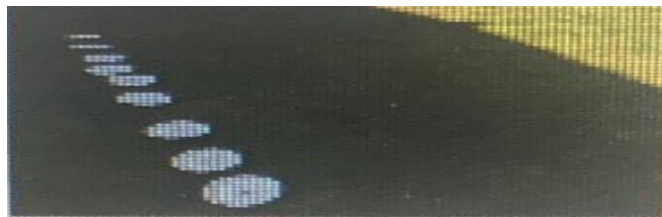
You will need: - paper plates and pens

How to Play

- Write the target phoneme on an individual paper plate using one colour of pen.
- Then use a different colour pen to write single sounds that will go with the target phoneme to make words.



- For example, if the target phoneme is 'sh' you would write that on one plate and letters that would make words containing 'sh' on the other plates – e.g. d, i, o, p, c, r, a
- Lay the plates out randomly in a straight line in your 'throwing area'.



- Ask someone to give you a word to spell, e.g. 'shop'. Then segment (split) the word 'shop' into its sounds sh – o – p.
- Run and find the beginning sound 'sh' and frisbee it into the throwing space before running to find the next sound 'o' and frisbee throw that into the space, before finding the final sound 'p' and throwing that.

***Ask a grown up to model how to throw the plates like a frisbee and explore which way up the plate needs to be to travel further.**

- Then run to collect the sounds and arrange the plates to spell the word.
- Repeat as many times as you like using different words to reinforce the target sound.
