Literacy

Common words

This week we will be learning the last set of Primary 1 common words.

1. Learning new words- set 1 – Look at page 2 of **Week 33 – consolidating ck ai – teaching new common words.pdf** Try to sound out the words and ask an adult to help.
 - a. **our** – this word is tricky. You are going to have to learn it as a sight word. It has 2 phonemes(sounds) **ou + r** We will learn the **ou** phoneme in P2. Ask an adult to tell you the **ou** sound. You can sound out the **r**
 - b. **down**– this is tricky too. You are going to have to learn it as a sight word. **d + ow + n** You can sound out **d** but the **ow** is a phoneme you will learn in P2 and it has two sounds **ow** -as in ‘owl’ and **ow** -as in ‘show’. Ask an adult to tell you the **ow** (as in owl) sound. It makes the same sound as **ou** in the ‘our’ word, then you can sound out the **n**.
 - c. **off**– You can sound out the **o**. The **f** is double trouble for spelling but you only say the **f** sound once when you sound it out. **o + f**
2. Look at pages 3-5.
 - a. Each word has been split into vowels (letters in red) and consonants (letters in blue). Count how many letters make up the word, count how many vowels and count how many consonants there are. Look at the shape of the word. Are there any tall letters? Are there any lazy letters (that would hang off the line f,g,j,p,q or y)?
 - b. Trace your fingers on the words written in dotty letters
 - c. Write your words out 3 times. Try to use correct formation, size and if using lined paper sit your letters on the line – the **f** should be tall and have a monkey tale hanging under the line, the **d** is tall also.

You have completed all the Primary 1 common words. Well done.
