Our young people continue to respond very well to the current timetable as we support their return to in-school learning. It remains incredibly important that all our young people maintain their engagement with the online learning that is made available to them. SQA UPDATE FOR PARENTS OF PUPILS IN S4-6

All parents/carers of pupils in S4-6 will receive a copy of a letter from Derek Brown (Executive Director for Education and Families). This includes an important update regarding the process of making and communicating decisions about our young people's SQA grades.

To support parents/carers and young people to know which areas of study need particular attention for the last full month of learning and teaching, an updated will be provided next week. This should help young people to focus their Easter Study and personal study plans.

F.A.C.T.S.—KEEPING US ALL SAFE

As more pupils return to school and join the LFD Asymptomatic Testing programme, it is essential that we remain aware of the core safety requirements: **FACE COVERINGS; AVOID CROWDS; CLEAN HANDS; 2 METRES; SELF-ISOLATE IF EXPERIENCING SYMPTOMS**. I would kindly ask all families to review these basic safety measures once again. If your young person has not yet returned a consent form to join the testing programme, they should do this next week to begin testing on the next Thursday or Monday. After the Easter break, S1-3 pupils will be able to participate in the testing programme.

Fr Frank has been with us over the past year to support the spiritual life of the school. During this challenging time, Fr Frank has supported our young people and staff through his involvement in classes, and the celebration of the Sacraments.
