SQA Provisional Results for S4-6 pupils

Pupils in S4-6 will be provided with their Provisional Results which the school will be submitting to the SQA by Friday 25th June. Pupils will receive their Provisional Results as follows:

- S4-5 pupils will receive a printed copy of their results in class on Monday. Pupils should attend school as normal and follow their Week 2 timetable, and their results will be brought to them before the end of the day.
- S6 pupils will receive an email with their results in the afternoon on Monday
