

In literacy, we are learning:

- **Reading** – continuing to develop our fluency, accuracy, reading rate and comprehension using the Dandelion Readers and Read, Write Inc Fresh Start programmes.
- **Talking and listening** – taking turns to ask relevant questions, show my understanding by answering questions and giving explanations, summarising the points of a discussion, talk about my personal experiences, explain how I have carried out a process or solved a problem.
- **Phonics/spelling** – building our knowledge of the phonemes in Set 3 of the RW:Inc FreshStart programme. Continuing to learn the spellings for tricky red words. Revisiting the phonemes from Set 1 & 2.
- **Writing Focus** – developing our understanding of the features of the narrative, persuasive and recount writing genres.

Numeracy

- **Multiplication and Division** – multiply and divide whole numbers using a range of strategies.
- **Fractions, Decimals and Percentages** – explain what a fraction is, find part of a shape or quantity, add fractions to make a whole.
- **Expressions and Equations** – using equal to, less than, more than, solving simple algebraic problems where a symbol represents a number

Maths

- **Measure – Length, Height, Volume, Capacity & Mass** – estimating, comparing, measuring, converting, reading scales & using measuring equipment to explore measure.
- **Maths and its impact on the world (past and present)** – investigate the importance of numbers and number systems in learning, life and work
