When we come to school in the morning we will come in through these gates and make our way down into the playground.




At 9.00am the bell rings and we line up with our class.

Here, we can be served breakfast from the friendly catering staff and sit next to our friends in the school cafeteria. At 8.45am we can also join our friends in the playground.






Our Cloakrooms


