

In literacy:

- **Reading**- we are learning about taking notes and finding the main ideas in our reading books.
- **Talking and listening**- we are learning to research a topic and to then report back to the class.
- **Talking and listening**- we are learning to ask questions about other group's presentations.
- **Phonics/spelling** – we are learning and revising our Common words and are developing these phonemes (ow, ou, igh, y, i-e, o-e, oe, ough, u, gn, t, dge & o).
- **Writing** – we are learning to write 2 sentences with describing words in Colourful Semantics.
- **Writing** – we are learning to write recounts, sense poems and instructions.
