- **Reading**
Children will use a range of strategies to help develop reading fluency and comprehension.
- **Talking and listening**
Children will take part in some talking and listening activities through different media and group work.
- **Phonics/spelling**
Children will develop their knowledge of phonemes and spelling rules that helps them to learn to spell unfamiliar words.
- **Writing**
Children will be creating narrative and discursive pieces of writing.

Wider Curriculum
