

In literacy, we are learning:

Phonics & Spelling

- Revising phonemes and learning new one and using these confidently when reading and writing.
- Revising and learning **common words** and using these accurately in our writing.

Reading

- Using phonics and other reading strategies to work out unfamiliar words.
- Developing our **reading comprehension** by discussing texts and answering questions about what we have read.

Writing

- Becoming more confident and independent writers.
- Writing in more detail and developing our ideas.
- Writing a sequence of sentences that make sense and link together.
