



<u>Maths</u>

- Snow depth challenge Measure the depth of snow in your area..
- Pick a number and list as many ways as you can to make that number e.g 25
- Go through a catalogue and find as many items as you can starting with the initial letter of your name.
- Make a sphere, cylinder, cone and a cuboid using snow.
- Make a 2D snowman and write the shapes that you used.
- Calculate how many footsteps it would take you to walk around your room or garden.

<u>General</u>

- Make a snow angel and take a photograph of it.
- Snow scavenger hunt: Can you spot 6 of these winter things outside?

- Make a bird feeder to hang in your garden. You can use an empty coke bottle or a margarine tub.
- Make a snowflake.
- Design a Christmas card, sledge, a pair of winter boots
