Activities planned for within the DYW council provide a platform for children to discuss skills development and how they can be transferred to the world of work




VISITS

Our children have many opportunities to discuss DYW matters in a variety of settings. They are given the opportunity to present to the class, during assemblies and to adults that visit the school.


It is important that children understand the skills they are being taught and how they could go on to use these particular sets of skills as they embark on higher education and into work and is an integral part of all planning.
