Recycle

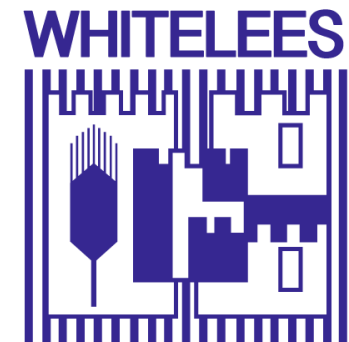
- Stamp collection for RNIB
