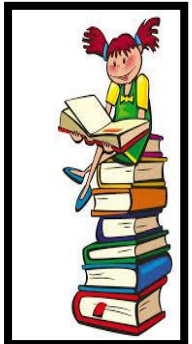

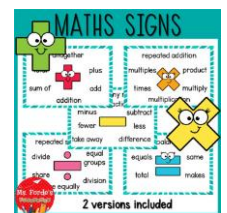
PE Kit should be:
