## Overview or Term

Our topics this term are Influential Scots, Scotland vs Australia, and Climate and Weather. We will be exploring aspects of Scottish history and learning about influential Scots and their impact on society.

## Literacy

The children will use their understanding of number and numeracy concepts to explore a range of topics. This will include shape, money, fractions and decimals. For outer maths the children will explore time and patterns and relationships. We will reinforce the relevance numeracy has within daily life and the world of work.

The children should continue to practice their 2,3,4, 5 and 10 times tables at home.
