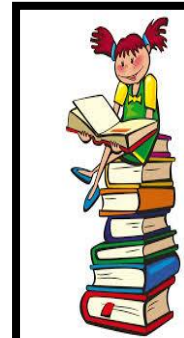




Welcome back to another busy term. We hope that you had a good Easter break and ready to take on the challenges this term brings. We are working hard in class.

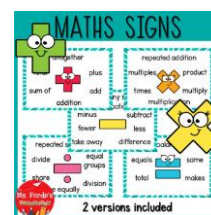
PE Kit should be:
