



# Entry (1:50-2:00pm)

Please enter through the doors that your child enters each morning. This will let you see how the children enter our school building. School staff will be at each entrance to direct you to classes. Class teachers will start their presentations at 2:00pm so please arrive promptly so you do not miss any information. All children will be in the school hall for a whole school assembly, this will allow class teachers to take you through their presentation and provide an opportunity for you to ask any questions you may have. The children will then return to classes at approximately 2:25pm, where they will join parents/carers for an opportunity to share some learning opportunities. This will last for approximately thirty minutes and then you will be able to leave with your child at 3:00pm.

#### What if I can't make Meet the Teacher?

We understand that you may have other commitments at this time so please don't worry if you can't make this session. Meet the Teacher presentations will be uploaded to our school app so please make sure you have this downloaded to access school communication.

## If I don't attend, when will I receive my Class Dojo code?

For the remainder of the week, class teachers will take Dojo codes to the lines at the end of the day, where they will be able to hand codes directly to parents/carers. If you aren't present to collect your child, please call or email our clerical team to arrange a time for collection from the main school office.

#### What if I have more than one child at the school?

We would advise that you attend your youngest child's presentation as older children will be able to relay information to you clearer than younger children. After the presentation you'll be able to go between classes to share some learning opportunities with all children. The presentations will also be on our school app so you have all class information.

# How many parents/carers can attend the session?

We advise one adult to attend per child, a maximum of two adults per family. Our class sizes are quite restricted so space can be tight and for the comfort of everyone we will keep numbers limited. If you have more than one child, please feel free to have a different adult attend a different class.

### Will there be a nursery Meet the Teacher?

Each morning nursery parents/carers are able to enter the nursery and have an opportunity to meet with nursery staff. We will also hold a Nursery Curriculum Event on Monday 9th September 3:30-4:30pm. More information will follow.
