## Literacy

### **Numeracy:**

The children will use their understanding of number and numeracy concepts to explore a range of topics. This will include shape, money, fractions and decimals. For outer maths the children will explore time and patterns and relationships. We will reinforce the relevance numeracy has within daily life and the world of work.
