Literacy

This term the children will be focusing on elements of non-fiction texts within the class to further develop their comprehension skills. Specifically we will be exploring elements such as making notes to create texts, finding information from different sources, discussing the purpose and main idea of a text and further understanding the difference between fact and opinion.

We will also continue to use the comprehension strategies through exploring fiction texts such as The Nowhere Emporium.

Our writing focus for the coming term will be information reports and persuasive pieces..

We will continue to work through our **North Lanarkshire** spelling programme, exploring a range of spelling rules and common words.

Numeracy

Children will continue to develop their mental fluency and number skills using the **Number Talks** programme. This term we will be focusing on exploring strategies for **subtraction and multiplication** using carefully planned for 5-10 minute activities.

Within our wider maths children will continue to explore the theme of number, money and measure in greater depth.. We will be focusing on fractions, decimals and percentages; measure; expressions and equations; and patterns.

Health and Wellbeing

Physical Education Focus

Our P.E. days for this term will be a Thursday and Friday.

Indoor P.E. - Thursday, with a focus on badminton and netball.

Outdoor P.E. - Friday, with a focus on tag rugby followed by football.

Interdisciplinary Learning - This term our main IDL focus will be on looking at Sustainability—and how this can be achieved within Scotland. We will be discussing elements such as land use, I renewable energy and the sustainability goals.

Social Studies - As a school we have a focus on Scotland throughout this term and, as part of a history/geography based topic, the children will be learning more about the city of Edinburgh.

RME - At the beginning of the term we will be exploring Winter Festivals, from a variety of different religions and cultures.

Our outdoor learning will be planned for in a way that provides scope for children to further explore their class-based learning in different contexts.
