Thank you to all our parents who have already signed up to Parent's Portal. If you haven't already signed up please consider doing so. This is a one stop shop where you can report an absence, top up your child's dinner card, update contact details and sign permission slips amongst other things. This will also be where your child's report card will be published when the time comes, paper copies will no longer be sent home and copies will no longer be emailed.

### REMINDER

Please ensure your child brings their water bottle to school each day. These can be replenished at our water fountains. Increasingly children are coming to school without water bottles and unfortunately, we are unable to continue to supply disposable cups. If you are unable to provide a water bottle for your child please contact the school office who will be happy to arrange one for them.



Please remember to top up your child's dinner card online using Ipayimpact to ensure they have sufficient funds to pay for their lunch and breakfast (if they attend Breakfast Club).

The cost of a school lunch is £3.40.

If you haven't already returned your child's Annual Data Check and EV5 form distributed in August could you please make arrangements to return these? The Annual data Check will ensure we have the most up to date contact details for your child and the EV5 form will ensure we have permission to take your child on trips out with the school building. If you require these to be re-issued please contact our school office who will be happy to help.

Our Pantomime for P4 - P7 still remains open for payment on Ipayimpact. Thank you to those who have paid in full, this is greatly appreciated as we will have to pay the theatre in full at the end of October. If you haven't already paid, this fund will be open until 26th October. If you will be unable to make payment in full by this date please contact our school office who will be happy to make alternative arrangements for you.



Please do not use the staff car park to pick up/drop off your child at any time. This is for the safety of all our children, parents and staff. If you have no option but to use the car park please do not block our bin area as North Lanarkshire Council require access to these at all times. Increasingly we have parents/visitors with blue badges. We respectfully ask that the disabled spaces are kept free for these visitors/parents. If you are using the disabled space please display your blue badge.

Please be reminded that we are a **nut free** school. We have several children with severe nut allergies who could suffer a life threatening reaction.



Look out for your child's Latest and Best jotter coming home to you on Friday 21st November. These should be returned on Monday 24th November.

#### **NURSERY ENROLMENT 2026-2027**

The timeline for Early Learning and Childcare applications has changed.

Parents and carers of children turning three before the end of February 2027 should apply for an Early Learning & Childcare Placement from 6 October 2025.

The application form for 2026/27 will be available from this date. The deadline for applications will be 28 November 2025.

All children who will be three years of age before the 1 March 2027 will be entitled to receive up to 1140 hours statutory funded place during session 2026-2027. For session 2026-2027 starting on 1 August 2026, start dates for Early Learning and Childcare (ELC) placements will be in keeping with Scottish Government legislation and continue to allow for all eligible children to receive their statutory entitlement up to 1140 hours

The government funding start dates are where a child's third birthday fall on or between:

- 1 March and 31 August 2026 they will be eligible for funding from August 2026 (autumn term) occurring in that year.
- 1 September and 31 December 2026 they will be eligible for funding from January 2027 (spring term) following their birthday.
- 1 January and last day of February 2027 they will be eligible for funding from April 2027 (summer term) following their birthday.

Parents or carers of a child whose funded place will start at any of these times should apply from 6 October 2025.

Once the application form is available from Monday 6 October 2025, you should return your application with supporting paperwork (birth certificate and Council tax bill) by email, post or hand it in to your <u>first choice of ELC provider</u> by Friday 28 November 2025.

If you don't have a copy of your Council Tax bill you can register with the Council Tax portal and obtain a copy <u>View and manage your council tax account online | North Lanarkshire Council</u>

This deadline applies to applications for a funded place that is due to start at any time during the 2026/27 session, be it the Autumn 2026, Spring 2027 or Summer 2027 term.
