Literacy

This term the children will continue to explore both fiction and non-fiction texts to further develop their comprehension skills. As part of their fiction reading and comprehension strategies, the class will be using the novel The Demon Headmaster. Children will use the six comprehension strategies, as well as a number of different reading response tasks, to help them gain a better understanding of the text.

Our writing focus for the coming term will be narrative writing. The children will begin to create character and setting descriptions, as well as looking at plot and structure of this particular genre.

We will continue to work through our **North Lanarkshire** spelling programme, exploring a range of spelling rules and common words.

Numeracy

Children will continue to develop their mental fluency and number skills using the **Number Talks** programme. This term we will be focusing on exploring strategies for **addition** using carefully planned for 5-10 minute activities.

Within our wider maths children will continue to explore the themes of number, looking at written calculations, and towards the end of the term they will also being to explore money. Alongside this the children will continue to develop their number skills across the four operations through their daily mental opportunities.

Physical Education Focus
