



Nursery

We look forward to welcoming back our nursery children on **Monday 22nd of February**. In order to reduce the number of adults waiting at the nursery entrance we have made the decision to stagger entry/exit to and from nursery. The arrangements from Monday are as follows:

8.50am – 2.50pm Monkeys and Koalas

9.00am – 3.00pm Zebras and Giraffes

9.10am – 3.10am Tigers and Elephants

It is essential that to ensure the safety of all that these times are strictly adhered to therefore all children must be dropped off and collected promptly.



Pupils in Primary 1 -3

All pupils in primary 1-3 should return to school on **Monday 22nd of February** unless advised to shield or self-isolate. At this point all staff will resume full time face to face teaching and will no longer provide on line learning except in the circumstance where a child has been advised to isolate by Test and Trace or to shield by SG or GP. The NLC digital school is a continuous resource and can be accessed using the links posted on the school blog.

Primary 1 and Primary 2 will attend from **9.00am until 3.00pm** and enter via the main gate. To reduce congestions pupils will be able to enter from **8.50am**.

Primary 1/2 and Primary 3a will attend from **9.10am until 3.10pm** and enter via the main gate. To reduce congestions pupils will be able to enter from **9.00am**.

Primary 3b will attend from **9.10am until 3.10pm** and enter via **the yellow zone gate**. To reduce congestions pupils will be able to enter from **9.00am**.



Pupils in Primary 4 – 7


Pupils in P4-7 whose parents are key workers and those who have been identified by the school should continue to attend as agreed **from 9.00am until 3.00pm** and will enter and exit via the **yellow zone gate**.

For all other pupils their learning will continue online. However as more staff are now required to teach classes in school we have had to make some changes to how this is organised. Staff are working in teams and sharing the responsibility of online and class teaching to ensure that the high quality of online provision continues for all our pupils. Further information on this will be posted on your child's class team on Monday. We look forward to welcoming all of our P4-7 pupils back to school as soon as possible.



Breakfast Club

Following guidance from Scottish Government and NLC, **breakfast club provision will only be available to children of key workers and those identified by the school**. It is not therefore available to all pupils in P1-3.



School Gates

We would kindly remind all parents that they must socially distance when dropping off and collecting children from school and nursery and face coverings must be worn. It is essential for schools to remain safe that parents do not arrive early or linger at the entrances as this increases congestion and risk of transmission. No parents are permitted on school grounds and should your child have an appointment we would ask that you call the office who will escort them out to the gate at the appropriate time.

We appreciate that for many of you there will be feeling of both excitement at the return to school for your child but also apprehension as lockdown continues. We continue to ensure the safety of all of pupils and staff through robust approaches to risk assessment and rigorous cleaning procedures.
