#### Continuing Professional Development

As a staff we have been very busy with training on **Better Movers and Thinkers** for all classes and their teachers and **Number Talks** developing our Numeracy skills and strategies. Also Mrs Gibson is currently undertaking VERP training. Our Early Learning Practitioner, Michelle Liddell has enrolled on a Gaelic language course and will begin in February and Mrs. Flannigan,

our classroom assistant, is about to begin Indirect Dyslexia Training as part of a North Lanarkshire pilot.

## **RME** Information

Mrs Mackie teaches the children Religious and Moral Education at Tollbrae and over the next few weeks pupils in P2, P3 and P4/5 will be looking at places of worship and how people worship in Christianity (P2), Judaism (P3) and Islam (p4/5).

Primary 1 will be looking at a special time in the Jewish calendar called Rosh Hasannah (Jewish New Year). Primary 5 will be looking at symbols of the 6 main religions of the world and what they mean. Primary 6 will learn about Passover and the Sedar Plate and its importance. P6 and 7 will be learning about different aspects of Islam - Weddings (p6/7) and looking inside a Mosque (P7).

We hope to learn lots and get a better understanding of the different religions we have in the world.


