John Williams - My favourite Film Score

You will now choose your favourite piece of film music which John Williams composed and explain what musical features you can identify.

What is the tempo (speed) of the music? Can you think of the appropriate term to use to describe the tempo? Eg. Allegro, Andante, etc.
What is the main dynamic of the music? (slow/fast/moderately slow) Can you think of the Italian term used to describe the dynamic?
Can you identify anything interesting that happens in the music? Think about particular instruments that are used the most or do all of the instruments enter at once, etc.
