Actions Taken	
Class covered by another teacher	As and when the case arises of a teacher being off due to isolating they will be covered by supply. If there is no supply they will be covered, where possible, by the SfLT or the HT or an itinerant teacher.
Classes combined - Childcare provision	If there is no teacher available to cover, two classes will be combined and covered by one teacher and a SfLA, and/or other staff members. This in effect will become childcare with reduced teaching and learning activities. If there are three classes combined with appropriate ratio of adults including one teacher, this will become wholly a childcare provision. If the school has to combine as one, this will not meet current mitigations, and will be reviewed.
Pupils who are Isolating	
All Primary Pupils	Will be provided with one reading, writing and maths task whilst isolating due to COVID. Will be prepared with age appropriate online safety information. Will have access to Sumdog and be provided with other websites for use online during isolation.
P4-7 digital readiness	All pupils in P4-7 will have experience of logging into Glow and using the Teams platform in school. P4-7 pupils will have had experience of doing assignments and homework using the Teams platform in school and at least once at home. All P4-7 pupils will have had experience of uploading photos with additional text onto Seesaw in school.
P1-3 digital readiness	All pupils in P1-3 will have had experience of using Seesaw in school. Class Teachers will be prepared to upload a weekly video and activity onto Seesaw for all absences related to COVID isolating. A paper pack will be available for pupils who are absent due to COVID isolating.
Nursery digital readiness	Nursery staff will have a check-in opportunity via Seesaw to provide ideas and support for learning opportunities, for families who are COVID isolating. Parents and Carers will be encouraged to upload snapshots of play activities at home.
Staff who are Isolating	
Teaching staff	Online teaching responsibility for pupils also isolating. Focus on their leadership role and related reading and professional development. Contribution to whole school developments. Planning and preparation. Professional development including iLearn.
All other staff	Contribution to whole school developments. Online administrative duties. Preparation of resources. Online communications to organise running of school building. Paperwork and planning. Professional development including iLearn.
