SWIMMING

SCHOOL BUILDING

We have a new door in the P1/2 and Nursery corridor which was done last term. This was done to zone the nursery area for parents and to cut down on drafts. This has worked well and we will now work on creating a better space in our support for learning bay upstairs which should be happening in the February break.

Our heating system has been unreliable for some time, but our building inspector has been in and it seems to be fixed. It is very warm now and we are not anticipating any more disruptions as a result!

PLAYGROUND PLANS

We are extremely lucky to have the Parent Council working towards developing our playground. They have already started raising money, which is very impressive, and they have asked the children for ideas about what they would like for their playground.



The children were very positive and came up with suggestions for improvements and ideas for developing the spaces even further. We have already made some adjustments that the children felt would improve their play experience, and we asked each class to record ideas for future developments.

Today we had a playground assembly to make sure we had a good think about our Vision 'Learning to be our best together' inside the building and in the playground. Our Values 'Kindness, Responsibility, Respect, Honest and Friendship' and the rules we aim to achieve 'Ready, Respectful and Safe'. We made sure these were fundamental to the changes we wanted to make.



Our Pupil Council will now come up with a Playground Guidance which they will share with all the children and staff and they will present it to the Parent Council as one of their actions this year. This will help to make sure our children have great experiences inside and out.
