Overview

An opportunity for Primary 7 school pupils to take part in an exciting residential 'Outdoor Learning & Adventure Programme' away from home and fully immersed in the unique Hoy outdoor environment.

A 4 or 5-day residential programme based at the Hoy Centre set within a unique wild outdoor environment which aims to nurture, challenge, develop, and inspire participants.

The programme aims to offer participants positive outdoor experiences, develop environmental learning, and actively participate in practical outdoor skills.

The memorable experience will be evidenced and enriched through completing daily activity review sheets, an activity diary, and receive a National Outdoor Learning Award.

The Programme

The programme includes an action packed 4 or 5 days of outdoor learning and education.

Participants will work in small groups on both land and water which will include an

extensive choice of half and full day adventure activities.

Participants will have the opportunity to take part in up to 8 different half day activities and 1 full day activity. Each activity will focus on a wide range of age-appropriate learning outcomes in conjunction with the 'Curriculum for Excellence'.
