The library is divided into **FOUR** main sections.

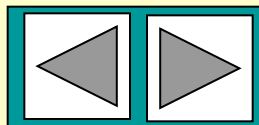
Fiction

These books are also known as novels.

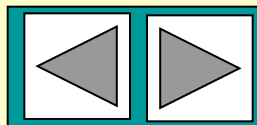


Reading Zone – Fiction Section

Senior Fiction



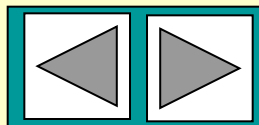
# Non-Fiction

There are 5 different parts to the Reference section:

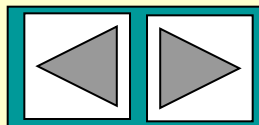
