## Parental Questionnaire Results

Full results from the recent Parent Questionnaire will be uploaded to our website shortly. We had a very positive response. Thanks to all who responded. Here are some of the key findings.....

- 96% strongly agreed or agreed on average with all 20 statements (3% N/A question wasn't relevant to them so didn't answer)
- Of 96%, 51% strongly agreed with statements (45% agreed)
- The 6 key statements for strongly agree (over 60% of responses) are:
  - My child enjoys being in school
  - School building is kept in good order
  - School is well led
  - School has a good reputation in the community
  - Parents evenings are helpful and informative
  - Staff make me feel welcome in the school
- Nobody strongly disagreed with any statement

## Areas which we feel we could be better at were:

- 'Parents having a clear idea of school priorities' (7% disagreed of 95% response)

Currently we share this information on the annual report issued in September and in the August or September newsletter. We will look at other ways to ensure parents are clear about what they are.
