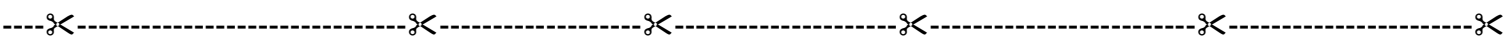
Advice on further work will be given if needed, helping to ensure bikes are roadworthy. Please leave your bike unlocked in the playground if you would like it checked.

Please note a free cycle safety check is not a substitute for a full service. Simple adjustments and repairs will be undertaken where necessary. Please see the attached MOT checklist on your bike at the end of the day for further details. In the event of a high number of bikes arriving on the day there may not be the opportunity to check all bikes.

Completed permission slips should also be returned to the school by Monday 20th November.
