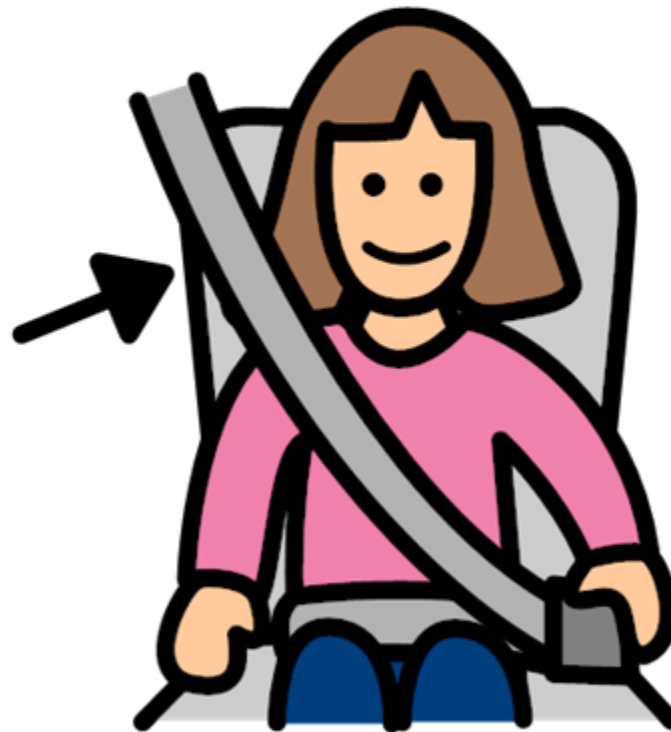


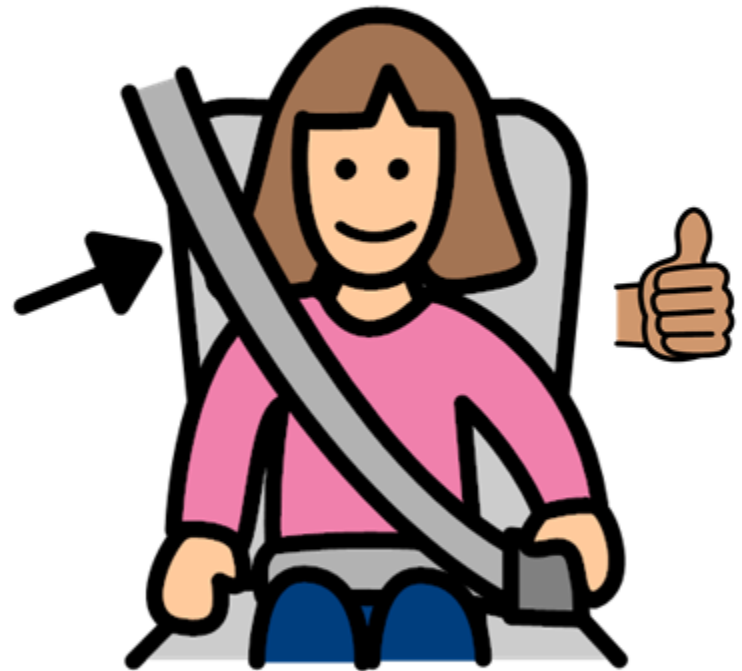
Wearing a seat belt.

car.



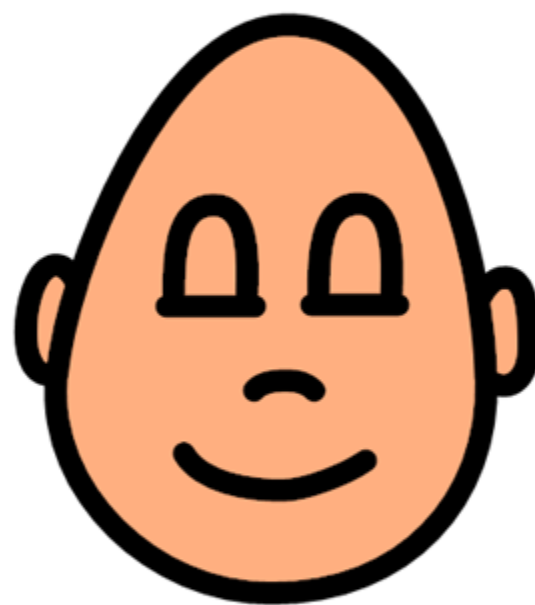
Wearing a seat belt

a good choice.



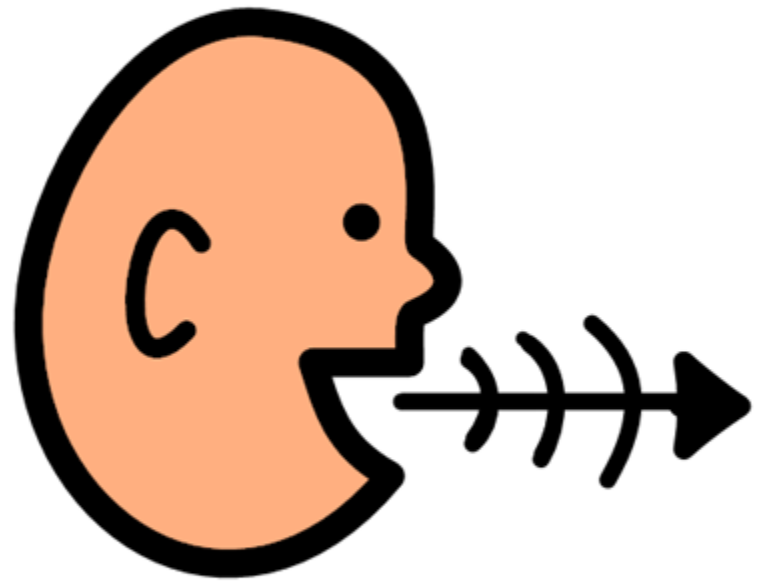
I wear a seat belt when I'm in my wheelchair. It keeps me safe and stops me from falling out.

to keep me safe.



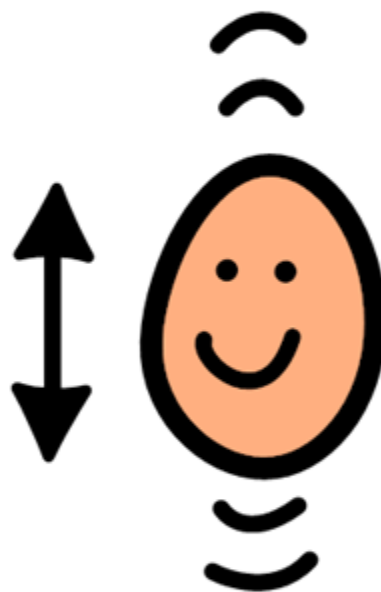
If it's too tight I can
