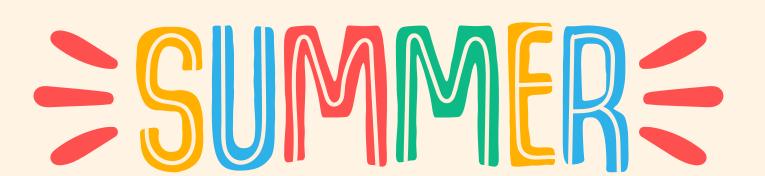

This is a joint Child Health AHP Advice Line with Occupational Therapy and Speech and Language Therapy colleagues also available to speak to on the same number.

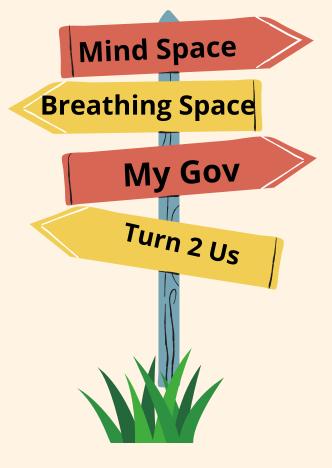
