AGM News

The Viewlands Primary Parent Council AGM was held on Monday the 4th November at the school. Over 25 parents attended, along with Mrs Allan, Mrs Sands from the SMT. Teachers Mrs Gellatley and Mrs Cahalin attended for their first meeting too. It was fantastic to see so many new faces at the meeting, making this the largest parent turnout at a Parent Council AGM in recent years. We now have the full quota of 20 parents on the council and we are all looking forward to working together for the benefit of the pupils and the school.

Despite the full quota of parent members on the council, all parents are always welcome at any of the up and coming parent council meetings - dates mentioned in the dates for your diary section of this newsletter.

During the recent Parent Council AGM, there was a healthy discussion amongst parents and staff about which initiatives and projects should next be supported by the Parent Council. Mrs Allan had consulted both staff and pupils of the school, and their suggestion was to upgrade the audiovisual equipment in the This investment in classrooms. technology would bring 14 new short throw projectors, 17 new speakers, and 2 new smart boards.

Other suggestions were discussed including upgrading playground structures, however this considered expensive. The discussion concluded with a majority vote in favour of supporting the suggestion from Mrs Allan for £4,000 to upgrade the Audio Visual Equipment. We should start to see the roll out of this equipment in the classrooms over the next 2 months.

The meeting also felt the parent council needs to hear the suggestions from all parents on what projects or initiatives should receive financial support in the coming months. So this is your chance to put forward your suggestions. Our starter for ten is giving each class some money to spend on their own projects which has been popular with both teachers and staff in the past, but we want to know your suggestions.
