#### Trip to Active Kids Adventure Park, Stanley - Friday 21st June '24

We have arranged an end of term trip to Active Kids Adventure Park in Stanley on Friday 21st June '24. Pupils should wear a school jumper, sensible shoes, bring a waterproof jacket and a sun hat. Pupils should come to school with suncream already applied if appropriate to the weather on the day. Pupils should bring a water bottle, snack and packed lunch (if not ordered a school packed lunch in advance).

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#### **Trip to Edinburgh Book Festival**

We have arranged a whole school trip to the Edinburgh Book Festival taking place on Thursday 22nd August 2024. This year we have booked to attend two shows: 'Jump into the SPOOKY World of Spoken Word' with Joseph Coelho and 'Fact-Checking Fairytales with SCIENCE' with Catherine Cawthorne and Sara Ogilvie. We are due to attend on the last day of the School Festival dates, therefore there will be additional activities on offer free of charge to pupils such as face painting, science demonstrations etc. as part of their annual Gala Day. If you do not wish your child to have their face painted or if they have any allergies to animals etc please let us know before the trip. We know what a valuable experience it is for our pupils to attend the Book Festival each year and are all really looking forward to going again in person. The bus will be leaving school at 8.00 a.m. prompt. Permission and school lunch orders should be completed on ParentPay by 10th June.

#### **Pantomime**

We have booked tickets for 'Mother Goose' at Perth Theatre on Thursday 12 December for the 10.30 a.m. performance. Tickets are priced at £11 (includes £2.50 booking fee) each. We are asking for a contribution of £8 per ticket and the school will subsidise the rest from our PEF Budget. The PSA have kindly agreed to pay the cost of the bus. It is on Parentpay now for payment. More details about the trip will be issued next term.
